

High-Impact Strategies for the Experienced Manager

This eight-day program will enhance the managerial skills and knowledge of experienced professionals whose primary job responsibilities include monitoring staff performance, long- and short-term planning, directing daily departmental operations, and reporting on programs and services.

Who Is Eligible?

This program is meant for department, unit, or program directors, and other experienced managers who develop programs and budgets, have supervised staff for at least five years and currently supervise at least three staff..

A B.A. or B.S. is required

Priority registration will be given to managers working within UJA's network of nonprofits.

What Happens in this Program?

In this highly interactive program, you can look forward to role-plays, small group discussions, peer coaching, fishbowls, and presentations. There will also be readings and assignments outside of class.

Your takeaway? Improved supervisory and interpersonal relationships. Increased ability to refine programs and services. Vision that aligns with agency mission. And improved work-life balance for you and your staff.

You'll also broaden your understanding of the issues facing the local Jewish community, and establish lasting connections with colleagues from across the field.

Certificate of Completion

In order to receive your certification, you must fully attend a minimum of six of the eight High-Impact Strategies sessions, submit a one-page overview and successfully deliver a 15-minute presentation of a strategic project.
