

What does the New York Rabbinic Fellowship for Visionary Leaders offer?

Time to reflect, refresh and reimagine your personal and professional vision for your rabbinate!

What are the key components of the Fellowship?

Executive level leadership training, self-assessment, and individualized coaching

-) Personal interaction with leading thinkers and scholars across a wide variety of disciplines
-) A supportive network of peers — New York rabbis from across the denominational spectrum
-) Exploration of critical issues facing synagogues and training in innovative, bold, and strategic approaches to address them
-) Development of skills for effective synagogue change, thought partnership, and community organizing
-) Ongoing support by SYNERGY, both during and after the fellowship, through supplemental training, learning opportunities, and resources for both rabbinic fellows and their lay leaders

Who's eligible to apply?

Mid-career congregational rabbis from across the denominational spectrum, who are a minimum of seven years post-ordination, and currently working in congregations in the greater New York area

What's the cost to participate?

In support of its strong commitment to strengthen New York synagogues, UJA-Federation of New York is investing in New York rabbis by significantly underwriting the cost of the 18-month-long fellowship.

In 2016, the program fee was \$2,500.

What's the commitment?

The fellowship consists of two immersive overnight retreats, 7 monthly in-person full-day workshops, 8 hours of individual professional coaching plus group coaching sessions, and moderate preparation for the monthly learning sessions.
