



**Sports for Youth
FY2018 Request for Application (RFA)
Funding Details and Application Directions**

UJA-Federation of New York cares for Jews everywhere and New Yorkers of all backgrounds, responds to crises close to home and far away, and shapes our Jewish future.

UJA-Federation of New York's Sports for Youth initiative seeks proposals from 501 (c) (3) not-for-profit organizations to provide grants for skill-based sports education and athletic equipment for underprivileged, at-risk, physically and mentally challenged young people in grades K-12 in New York City, Nassau, Suffolk and Westchester counties, and in Israel. Please note that these grants cannot be used for any equipment on any of the Henry Kaufmann Campgrounds.

The Sports for Youth committee will review all grant requests in June 2017 and choose the recipients based on the most effective deliverables to the students, including teaching the students specific sports skills.

Grants will be available in three types:

1) Grants of up to \$10,000 for renewal of currently existing grants, for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2017, which may eligible for funding for a maximum of three fiscal years, to be used for sports education programming;

2) Grants of up to \$15,000 for new grants for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2017, which may eligible for funding for a maximum of three fiscal years, and which may be used for either sports education programming or equipment; and

3) A one-time grant of up to \$40,000 for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017. This grant will only be awarded to one applicant. This grant can only be used to purchase equipment. On any equipment acquired using these funds, it is expected that there will be signage acknowledging that it was donated by Sports for Youth. Equipment grants are not renewable.

Please note that **current** grantees can **only** apply for **either** a renewal of a current grant **or** a new grant proposal; they may **not** apply for both. A grantee may apply for the \$40,000 equipment grant, regardless of if they are applying for a \$10,000 renewal grant, \$15,000 new grant, or neither.

Please note that, for those grantees completing both a FY2016-17 Mid-Year Report **and** a FY2017-18 Renewal Grant application, the information for both the current and proposed grants must be listed on a **single** financial reporting form.
